



# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### What equipment do I need? Can students play on a Chromebook?

Many schools have students participate in scholastic esports events from their own home **using their own equipment**. Most of the scholastic esports competitions offered by OSEA use cross-platform titles, which means they can be played by students on any gaming console.

That said, OSEA recommends creating a small, dedicated space (such a library or classroom) where students can compete at school together. Our games can be played on Nintendo Switch, PlayStation 4/5, Xbox One/Series, and PC, but not on Chromebooks.

The are many options available to schools and we'd love to help guide you in finding the best solution that will meet your needs!

#### How much does it cost?



School memberships cost \$100/year, which grants access to all our events and tournaments.

Teacher memberships are **FREE**!

Most of the games we use are also freeto-play!

## What if I don't know anything about gaming or esports?

#### What is expected of me as a coach?



Coaches are expected to be present with their teams at all times during scheduled games, either in person or virtually. Coaches are also expected to offer and support a regular practice time for students.

Season games are played on Wednesdays from 6:00pm to 7:30pm. Championship and tournament games are played on Saturdays starting at 9am.
